In the framework of a three-year project on inclusion of young children with special needs in primary schools in Lebanon, Youth Association of the Blind (YAB) is seeking to recruit a Special Education Coordinator to assist in coordinating, developing, monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of the IEP for each student with special needs.

As a Special Education Coordinator, you willcoordinate and assist special needs educators working in inclusive regular primary schools, monitor the inclusion of students with disabilities in regular schools in different areas in Lebanon, andperforms educational assessment of students with special needs. You will also be required to participate in team work, meetings, workshops or conferences directly related to the inclusion of students with disabilities in regular primary schools. Finally, you tasks will also include supervising, assigning, coordinating and participating in the work of the head office in Beirut.

While Youth Association of the Blind is based in Beirut, Karakol al-Druze area, your job will require you to work in different regions in Lebanon.

A bachelor degree in Special Education is a must, and so is a previous experience in this field of work, preferably for 3 to 5 years. You must be committed to working with children with special needs, and highly motivated, with good inter-personal skills and the ability to work in a team.
