



ANERA Lebanon Call for Consultants in Sports Development

CALL SUMMARY

ANERA Lebanon is carrying out a two-year program to enhance non-formal education in Lebanon, and is seeking the assistance of a Sports Development Expert to support its project team in a rapid assessment of sports in Nahr El Bared and Baddawi Palestinian refugee camps. The outcome of this assessment will guide the development of a two-year sports program aiming at promoting personal growth of youth in the two camps. Intervention is addressing sports clubs, vocational training and youth education community based organizations.

The incumbent should have an understanding of sports for development, with a combination of youth and sports education, and development experience, preferably with a background in sports education and in sports assessment work.

DURATION OF ASSIGNMENT

Work on this assignment is planned to begin immediately, and finish by end of July 2012.

QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates for this position are expected to have the following profile and qualifications:

- A Master's degree or equivalent work experience in a relevant field (sports education, education, community development, youth training and development);
- Proven experience in Sports Development programs within marginalized communities;
- Experience in assessing sports and in developing sports programs;
- Assessment, analysis, reporting and writing skills;
- Experience in non-profit organizations, project design and implementation is preferable;
- Knowledge of the Palestinian camps context in Lebanon is preferable.
